The Ordinary World: Setting, Personal Background & Situation of the Hero	
Call to Adventure: The Hero is presented with a problem or challenge, which shakes up his ordinary world.	
Refusal of the Call: The Hero hesitates or resists, but confronts fear and proceeds.	
Meeting with a Mentor: The Hero meets an advisor or guide who offers help. Sometimes this guidance is found within.	
Crossing the Threshold: The Hero commits to leaving the Ordinary World and undertaking the challenge.	
Tests, Allies & Enemies: The hero experiences further problems & tests along the way.	
Approach & Ordeal: The Hero faces his greatest challenge.	
The Reward: The Hero takes hold of the "treasure" or new life he is seeking and leads forward.	
The Road Back: The Hero confronts final tests, and resolves final conflicts.	
The Return: The Hero returns home or completes the journey with new knowledge to benefit or transform the Ordinary World he is returning to.
