

# THE HERO'S JOURNEY: LEARNING FROM BIBLICAL HEROES

Stage of The Hero's Journey	My Biblical Hero's Experience <i>Hero's Name:</i>
<b>The Ordinary World:</b> Setting, Personal Background & Situation of the Hero	
<b>Call to Adventure:</b> The Hero is presented with a problem or challenge, which shakes up his ordinary world.	
<b>Refusal of the Call:</b> The Hero hesitates or resists, but confronts fear and proceeds.	
<b>Meeting with a Mentor:</b> The Hero meets an advisor or guide who offers help. Sometimes this guidance is found within.	
<b>Crossing the Threshold:</b> The Hero commits to leaving the Ordinary World and undertaking the challenge.	
<b>Tests, Allies &amp; Enemies:</b> The hero experiences further problems & tests along the way.	
<b>Approach &amp; Ordeal:</b> The Hero faces his greatest challenge.	
<b>The Reward:</b> The Hero takes hold of the "treasure" or new life he is seeking and leads forward.	
<b>The Road Back:</b> The Hero confronts final tests, and resolves final conflicts.	
<b>The Return:</b> The Hero returns home or completes the journey with new knowledge to benefit or transform the Ordinary World he is returning to.
